Messaging and Comments

There are multiple ways for staff to engage with students to ensure they are on track. They can send messages directly to students or utilize the Scope & Sequence analytics to quickly identify the students who have not completed the required components of their CCR programming, then message and email students (and their guardians) that their attention is needed.

SchooLinks also has commenting throughout the platform. Comments allow for collaboration and messaging with context. Comments are visible to different stakeholders depending on the solution with SchooLinks. For example - comments on college favorites are visible to students, staff, and parents/guardians.
